Tournament Information

- 1. Only players who have registered and played a minimum¹ of 3 league matches during the current season will be eligible to play in this tournament with the exception of the junior and cadet singles where players must be registered members of the Association but with no minimum number of matches.
- Entry forms must be received by the Competition Secretary no later than 13th April 2024. Payment must be made in advance by direct credit to account number 23078760 sort code 30-18-45 using your name as the payment reference.
- 3. The draw will be made by the tournament organiser and will take place on 14th April 2024
- 4. Late entries will only be accepted if there is still space in the event after the closing date.
- 5. The venue will be open no earlier than 12:30pm.
- 6. No refreshments will be available on site on the day due to school restrictions.
- 7. There is ample free parking at the front of the school.
- 8. There are both male and female changing facilities on site.
- 9. Play will be on at least 10 Donic tables with Donic nets and posts.
- 10. Flooring is solid with a plastic surface suitable for table tennis.
- 11. Butterfly G40+ 3* white balls will be used.
- 12. Each table will be courted individually. Minimum court dimensions will be 9m x 5m with a minimum ceiling height of 5m from the floor.
- 13. Score machines will be used on all tables.
- 14. Lighting is general strip luminaire lighting. Light intensity is approximately 400 lux.
- 15. All events will be played best of 5 up to 11 with the exception of the handicap singles (1 game to 31).
- 16. The format of events will be a mixture of groups and straight knockout depending on the size of the entry.
- 17. Trophies will be awarded on finals night to all winners and runners up.
- 18. The finals of some events may be played on the day, others will be held on finals night.
- 19. There may be photography for promotional purposes; photos will only be published on the BDTTA website where there is consent.
- 20. Players may enter as many events as they wish subject to eligibility (see conditions 23-29 below).
- 21. All players must report to the control table on arrival and must not leave the hall without advising the organisers. Players absent when called upon to play are liable to be scratched.
- 22. All players will be required to umpire matches, not necessarily in their own event.
- 23. Players may only enter one age category.
- 24. Players must have reached the age of 40 by 1st January 2024 to play in the Veteran singles event.
- 25. Players must have reached the age of 55 by 1st January 2024 to play in the Super Veteran singles event.
- 26. Juniors must have been aged under 18 on 1st January 2024.
- 27. Cadets must have been aged under 15 on 1st January 2024.
- 28. Premier Division singles may be restricted from the top players (in the ranking list, not the averages). The number is to be decided upon receipt of all entries.
- 29. Players may enter one divisional singles event which may be their own or a higher division.
- 30. Some events may be merged/cancelled if there are insufficient entries.
- 31. Times listed are approximate. Players should aim to arrive at least 30 minutes before their first event starts to sign in/ warm up etc. Events may start earlier than scheduled.

Note that the Division 2 Singles event may also be opened to a maximum of 8 juniors or cadets at the invitation of the Head Coach
